Rules & Entry Form

Categories (prizes in brackets: (1st / 2nd / 3rd))

1. Open Poetry (Marian Mayne Prize: \$250 / \$150 / \$100)
***Themed: Environment/Climate Change**
2. Open Short Story (CJ Dennis Society Prize: \$250 / \$150 / \$100)
***Themed: Environment/Climate Change**
3. Poems written by adults for children (\$250 / \$150 / \$100). There will also be a prize of \$150 for the poem in this category chosen as the best by a group of local children.
4. Primary school students: preps to grade 6 (\$30 / \$20 / \$10)
5. Secondary school students: years 7-12 (\$50 / \$30 / \$20)



If you are NOT already a member of the CJ Dennis Society and are entering the 2020 Poetry Competition and you would like to join, read on!

We are offering this limited opportunity to join at a reduced fee for your first twelve months of membership. Instead of paying the normal \$25 we will reduce the price to \$15 when you enter the poetry competition too.

Rules:

1. **Entries must be postmarked by 1st September 2020** and paid for by cheque, money order or direct deposit for **\$15 per adult entry (student entry is free)**. The fee increase cost of each entry will cover the cost of sending the certificate(s) and a copy of the anthology to every entrant.
2. Cheques and money orders are to be made payable to: “CJ Dennis Society”. For multiple entries, please send one cheque or money order for the total fees. Or fees can be paid by direct deposit to “The CJ Dennis Society Inc”; BSB: 633000; Account No: 143129773 (Please use your surname as reference and include a copy of the bank receipt with your entry.)
3. **No late entries will be accepted. Entries postmarked after 1st September 2020 will be returned to sender. No correspondence will be entered into and the decision will be final.**
4. Entries will be accepted from authors throughout **Australia** and **New Zealand**.
5. Entrants who are unfamiliar with the remarkable versatility of CJ Dennis’s work, whether poetry or prose, can find many examples collected by Perry Middlemiss online.
6. **Poems entered must have good rhyme and metre. There is an 80-line limit for each poem entered in the Open section and a 40-line limit for each poem entered in the Adults Writing for Children section. There is a 500-word limit for each short story.**
7. Each poem or short story entered must be the original work of the entrant and must not have been placed first in any other competition at the date of entry or published for profit. The aim of the competition is to encourage writing which celebrates the work of CJ Dennis and relates to Australia’s people, events or environment, either historical or contemporary. **Limit of 2 poems per entrant per category and two short stories per entrant.**
8. Please send 2 copies of each poem or short story entered.
9. Each poem or short story should be typed on plain A4 paper in 12 point Times New Roman, single-spaced and, if longer than one page, the pages must be numbered. If typing is a problem for the author, handwritten work will be accepted, provided the handwriting is clear and a black or dark blue pen is used. Do not include photos or illustrations and do not send email entries.

10. **The author's name or other identification must *not* appear anywhere on the entry, only on the entry form.**
 11. All entries must be written in English.
 12. Entrants must complete an entry form to accompany the entry or entries.
 13. Copyright for all entries submitted remains with the author. Authors give permission to the CJ Dennis Society to publish their poem or short story in an anthology of short-listed entries to be published after the close of the competition and to post their poem or short story online. **There will be no payment (other than any prize money) made to authors of published entries.**
 14. Please keep a copy of your poem or short story, as entries will not be returned.
 15. For entries selected for inclusion in any anthology, the publisher reserves the right to edit the works; any editing will be confined to correction of spelling and punctuation where warranted (no 'corrections' will be made to the use of slang).
 16. The judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 17. Prize winners will be contacted however due to the uncertainty presented by the Corona Virus prize presentation details will be advised separately.

CHECK LIST

Please double-check that you have complied with the above rules, as this makes the task easier for the organisers and judges. To help, please use this checklist:

- **no name or other identifier** (such as email) on the entries mailed by **1st September 2020**
- **2 copies**, typed in **Times New Roman** font, 12 point, single spacing (or, if hand-written, **black/dark blue pen, written clearly**)
- typed/written on **one side** only **with pages numbered** if more than one page per entry celebrating the work of CJ Dennis and relating to an Australian subject or theme of the year if there is one
- each short story entered is **maximum 500 words**
- each poem entered is **maximum 80 lines (Open section) or 40 lines for all other sections** and has **good rhyme and metre**.
- no entry has won a 1st prize anywhere else and has not been published for money
- **paid for by cheque, money order or direct deposit** (\$15 per poem/short story; students free)
- **NO stamps required to be enclosed**
- **entry form** completed, signed and enclosed
- Attach bank receipt when paying by direct deposit or money transfer
